





he Government of the U.S. Virgin Islands is comprised of 55 agencies and more than 27,000 covered members across three islands St. Thomas, St. Croix and St. John. The Government's medical and dental eligibility discrepancies were reaching an all-time high with thousands of unexplained inconsistencies. With over 7,300 active employees, over 7,000 retirees and almost 12,000 dependents, there was a lot of work to do. The Government selected Bentek to help and through collaborative efforts by Government staff, Bentek, and the insurance carrier, the source of the discrepancies was identified and clean up could begin.
